The Spirit of Motivational Interviewing "ACE"

Autonomy not Authority

• It is the client who is in charge of his or her change process and whether or not he or she will make any change at all.

Collaboration not Confrontation

 Partnership that supports the self-efficacy of the patient

Evocation not Education

 The patient is the expert and we elicit insight rather than impart information and "wisdom".

The Principles of Motivational Interviewing "RULE"

R – Resist the "Righting Reflex" **U** – Understand your Patient's Motivations **L** – Listen with Empathy **E** – Empower Your Patient
